Dear Parent,

I hope you are well and looking forward to the warmer weather when it eventually arrives!

As I am sure you will be aware we completed the Year 10 Mock assessments just before we broke for the Easter holidays. These assessments have been marked by the teachers and assessed across the department with moves considered to find the best opportunity for your son as we approach the end of Year 10.

Taking the assessments, individual classroom performances and the disruption caused by covid and home schooling into account, we have kept any changes to a minimum to take advantage of the relationships built between your son and his teacher. This has resulted in a minimal number of class moves, which we believe the boys will see to be advantageous.

The small number of moves have been discussed and agreed with Mrs Babayan, the Head of Year 10. We have informed the boys of these changes and moved them into these revised groups today.

The department are fully aware that further tweaks may still be needed as the boys mature and further develop their knowledge and skills, but these will be dealt with on a more individual basis. The next scheduled time that the department would look at set changes will be following their Year 11 Mock exams at the end of the Michaelmas Term 2023.

I hope this gives you a reasonable understanding of our process moving forward and enough information to help you answer any questions from your son if the topic of group changes is mentioned at home.
