• Tennis @ Wrecclesham

Musical Theatre: 17:00 - 17:30 (£7 per session)

LAMDA Speech and Drama: 17:30-18:00 (Solo - £20, Duo - £12.50 or Group -£10)

These sessions and costings are independent of one another, so your son can do one, two or three of the weekly sessions. With props and magic books to record weekly achievements you can build your repertoire and wow your audience. There are two available weekly slots for **Young Magicians** (**Tuesday 1210-1300**) and one for the **Senior Magicians** (**Tuesday 1310-1400**). Magicians club starts on **18th January and runs weekly** at <u>a termly cost of £70.00 for Juniors and £100.00 for Seniors.</u> This includes the cost of all the paraphernalia (sticker books, use of magic equipment etc.). • Judo

They say 'Dan is the man'! Well, come and join our Dan Black Belt and former British Judo Team member, David Johnston. The cost of the activity is <u>£55.00 per term or £60.00 with kit hire</u>. The activity commences **Thursday 20th January** and takes place between **4.30pm and 5.30pm**.

• Squash @ The Bourne Club

After a two-year hiatus, we are delighted to offer Squash as an after-school activity once again. These sessions will take place on Tuesdays between 16:30-17:30 in Lower Bourne with a professional and enthusiastic coach. Based on the optimum number of 8 students, the total termly cost per pupil for 9 sessions will be **£78.75**. The first session starts on **Tuesday 18th January**.

Karate

Due to the immense popularity of Judo, the school are very keen to establish another martial art that will help the boys with flexibility, coordination and discipline. We are thrilled to host Surrey Karate on site on Wednesdays between 16:30-17:30. Corin Pegden will be the lead instructor with sessions occurring weekly from **Wednesday 19th January**. Each session costs **£5 per pupil**. There are 9 weeks this term, so the total cost **is £45.** A minimum of 10 pupils is required to make this a viable club.
